Course description

This course will focus on how to develop the narcissistic transference in the beginning stages of treatment and the Modern Analytic techniques that activate its development. A more in-depth understanding of how to use these techniques will be acquired through the use of specific dialogue from cases. Particular emphasis will be placed on comprehending the contact function of the ego, the object-oriented question and the utilization of joining techniques, as the specific techniques most relevant to the development of the narcissistic transference. In addition, the concept of the priorities of resistance will be introduced, as well as an understanding of how these priorities or stages of treatment are indicators of the client’s progress towards “cure.”

Course Objectives

1. To recognize the necessity of developing the narcissistic transference as a means to provide therapeutic “cure” for the primitive narcissistic disorders.
2. To develop an understanding of the Modern Analytic techniques that activate the development of the narcissistic transference
3. To gain understanding of the priorities of resistance and how they are indicators of the client’s stage of treatment.
